

Consecration to Mary for Little Ones – Week One

Day 1 – September 4th

Behold your mother. – John 19-27

Did you know that there is a queen in heaven who has a special mission for you? Her name is Mary. She is not only a queen. She is also the Mother of God and your mother, too. You are going to learn all about Mary in these reflections. You will also learn about the special mission she has given you. Be sure to pay close attention and open your heart to the love of your heavenly queen.

Prayer: Mary, I am so glad you are my mother in heaven!

Day 2 – September 5th

And Mary said, "My soul magnifies the Lord." – Luke 1:46-55

What do you know about this heavenly queen? Mary gave birth to Jesus in Bethlehem, raised him when he was a boy, and suffered beside him as he was dying on the cross at Calvary. God gave Mary a wonderful and very special mission. God gave Mary the mission of being the mother of Jesus, Christ the King.

Prayer: Mary, thank you for being Jesus' mother!

Day 3 – September 6th

I am the Immaculate Conception. – Our Lady of Lourdes

In order for Mary to fulfill her mission of bringing Jesus to us, God made Mary the Immaculate Conception. This means that when God created Mary, she did not have any sin on her soul. She also never sinned throughout her life on earth. This way Jesus could come to earth through Mary, so pure and sinless.

Prayer: Mary, I am so happy that you are the Immaculate Conception!

Day 4 – September 7th

God the Father gathered all the waters together and called them the seas (Maria in Latin). He gathered all his graces together and called them Mary. – St. Louis de Montfort

God did not need to create Mary. He could have sent Jesus a different way, using a different plan. But he decided to use Mary, a simple young girl, to bring God into the world. In Mary, pure and holy, our savior entered this world. Mary replied, "Be it done unto me according to thy word!"

Prayer: Mary, I am so happy God chose you to bring Jesus into the world!

Day 5 – September 8th

The Son of God became man for our salvation but only in Mary and through Mary. – St. Louis de Montfort

God's plans are always amazing. They are more beautiful than you can imagine. God's plan for Mary is just that: remarkable! Why would God choose to use a young girl to send the Son of God into this world? Maybe he chose her to show the power of God. Maybe he chose Mary so you can see how a young girl or boy can do great things for God.
